DIRECTIONS

FROM THE EAST: Take Interstate #80 West to Exit #34A (Wharton Boro, Route #15 Exit). Route #15 South to first traffic light (E. Dewey) make a right. Take E. Dewey to North Main Street (first traffic light) make a left. The American Legion is approximately ¼ mile down. (99 North Main Street)

FROM THE WEST: Take Interstate #80 East to Exit #34 (Wharton Exit). Follow North Main Street

FROM THE NORTH: Take Route #287 South to Interstate #80 West and follow the (From the East) directions listed above, or take Route #15 South into Wharton and follow the (From the East) directions listed above, or take Route #206 South to Route #80 East and follow the (From the West) directions listed above.

FROM THE SOUTH: Take the Garden State Parkway North to Route #287 North to Interstate #80 West and follow the (From the East) directions listed above, or take Route #206 North to Interstate #80 East and follow the (From the West) directions listed above, or take the Garden State Parkway North to Route #280 West (Exit #145) to Interstate #80 West and follow the (From the East) directions listed above.
