Job Title: Maintenance Mechanic

Job Summary:

The Maintenance Mechanic works under the supervision of the Superintendent of Production or Maintenance Planner. This position operates, repairs, installs, and maintains equipment at the pumping station, water storage facilities, booster stations, metering pits, and well fields.

Work Performed:

1. Maintain instrumentation including: Flow and pressure meters and recording devices, telephone transmitters and receivers, chemical release detection equipment, and computer equipment.
2. Maintain chemical feed equipment including chlorinators and chemical metering pumps.
3. Maintain facility heating and air conditioning equipment.
4. Maintain and test system protection equipment including surge relief valves, altitude, air, and pressure relief valves.
5. Maintain and test emergency equipment including backup generators, emergency lights, and chlorine release response equipment.
6. Maintain pumping equipment including lubrication, packing, vibration analysis, assembly, and disassembly and electrical and SCADA troubleshooting.
7. Maintain equipment repair records and parts inventories.
8. Perform inspections of plant equipment, intake station, and metering pits.
9. Perform emergency chemical release response and emergency equipment repair after suitable training period.
10. Perform plant and facilities start up or shut down.
11. Perform chemical receiving at main treatment plant, designated remote facilities, and safe handling including 150# chlorine cylinders.
12. Perform installations or modifications to equipment and facilities as required for the operation of existing or newly installed facilities.

Work Performed (continued):

13. Attend both in-house and vendor sponsored training courses and seminars.
14. Assume on-call responsibilities after a suitable training period and work short notice overtime as required.
15. Perform duties on weekends and holidays as scheduled.
16. Snow removal at CJO Plant and remote facilities.
17. Clean various basins, storage tanks and reservoirs as necessary.
18. Perform all related duties as required by supervisor.
19. Schedule maintenance activities when the Maintenance Planner and/or Superintendent of Production are unavailable.
20. Adhere to and promote the Company safety policy and practices as it pertains to the job.

NOTE: Some mandatory overtime will be required as necessary to maintain facilities operation.

Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Valid Driver's license required.
- Ability to obtain a CDL for the transportation of chlorine (Haz Mat Endorsement) within one year of employment required.
- Must have at least six years experience in the operation and maintenance of equipment pertinent to water facility operations.
- A specific trade skill in chemical feed system, carpentry, electrical, plumbing, etc. may be required at time of hire.
- Must have the ability to obtain T-1 license within three years of date of employment.
