Key Accountabilities

- Operates remote production facilities, electrical, pumping and high service equipment, chemical processing equipment, pumps, valves, and standby generation equipment to ensure the safe, reliable production and delivery of the highest quality water.
- Performs and/or assists with repairs to company equipment and/or facilities.
- Reviews, monitors, and adjusts hydraulic and chemical processes to achieve and maintain established water quality standards and system requirements.
- Prioritizes and coordinates tasks and/or activities required for the efficient and reliable operation of water systems and related appurtenances.
- Maintains the appearance of facilities and grounds in accord with company standards. Prepares and maintains accurate system records and reports.

Knowledge/Skills

- Working knowledge of the distribution system network including, but not limited to, gradients, capacities, interconnections, mapping, service territory and facility locations as well as a thorough understanding of water treatment processes at remote facility locations, including, chemical feeds, such as chlorination and corrosion control to ensure the safe, reliable, and efficient operation of the water treatment facility and related appurtenances.
- The Station Operator must be capable of operating equipment necessary for the completion of assignments and possess a valid Driver's License. The individual will also be required to pass an initial and annual TCPA and OSHA medical examination and must be able to perform the essential functions and meet the physical requirements for Station Operator.
- Working knowledge of company policies, procedures, and safety practices as well as state and federal rules and regulations applicable to area of responsibility including, but not limited to, TCPA and OSHA. The Station Operator will be required to become an EHS Operator and a certified Emergency Responder Technician.
